This has been questioned by the industry as they were concerned that this could have the a major effect on the resale value of the vehicle. An email was forwarded by the industry as they were losing sales to TFNSW who responded that day with a positive which suggested that TFNSW were not following up on this matter providing the vehicle re assessed by a 	
		 VSCCS certifier should the vehicle by sold. This relates to the minimum 50mm head height clearance for wheelchair occupants and supported with a medical report. Member discussions suggested that disability vehicles will need to assessed case to case. (In particular highly modified transportation wheelchair modified vehicles). TFNSW have stated that minor modifications like hand controls when removed do not require a modification certificate providing the vehicle is brought back to its original STD OE condition.
